St. Paul, Minnesota has been home to the Twin City Model Railroad Museum since its beginning in 1934. The Museum is currently located in historic Bandana Square and the adjacent “Chimney’s” building.

During the height of the steam era, the Northern Pacific Railroad operated its maintenance facility here to repair their passenger fleet.

Today, the remnants of a transfer table and sand tower can be seen on the premises as well as a steam locomotive and water tank. What an appropriate location for a model railroad museum!
